Course Overview: FEMA-74 Reducing the Risks of Non-Structural EQ Damage

This course describes the sources of nonstructural earthquake damage and provides information on effective methods of reducing potential risks from such damage. The training also includes a component to assist in identifying potential hazards and provides specific information on upgrades that the audience can do themselves.

Course Overview: FEMA 154-RAPID Visual Screening

This is a half (1/2) day course on Rapid Visual Screening of Buildings for Potential Seismic Hazards (RVS) was developed as a pre-disaster procedure that can be implemented relatively quickly and inexpensively within a community to develop a list of potentially hazardous buildings without the high cost of a detailed seismic analysis of individual buildings. This process may also prove beneficial for determining potential vulnerabilities from acts of terrorism for certain types of structures. Based on this detailed inspection, engineering analyses, and other detailed procedures, a final determination of the need for rehabilitation can be made.

Target Audiences

The target audiences for the training are building owners, facility managers, maintenance personnel, homeowners, store or office managers, business proprietors, organizational department heads, and others concerned with building safety and the continuation of business.
